

XIX Pitch&Putt Italian Open – 2023 October the 14th and 15th

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Open will be held in accordance with:

- I. the rules of R&A, IPPA and FIP&P
- II. the number of irons allowed is maximum 3, including a putter
- III. departures on the synthetic mat
- IV. any condition notice relating to the competition in question
- V. any additional conditions and local rules promulgated by the Committee and in accordance with the following conditions
- VI. tee is optional

2. THE COMPETITION

54 holes medal stroke play scratch

October 14th: 1st and 2nd round - 36 holes medal stroke play (tee time decided from Committee)

October 15th: 3rd round - 18 holes medal stroke play

3. ADMISSION

The competition is reserved to players:

- I. complying with the rules of justice FIP&P or equivalent
- II. complying with any conditions of admission set out in tournament conditions specifications of the tournament in question
- III. complying with the disposition of the Federation which they belong to

4. ENTRYLIST

The maximum number of entries: 72.

In case of overbooking, the principle adopted for the exclusion will be the Exact handicap; if two or more players have the same hcp, the Committee will consider date and time of registration.

Priority will be given to foreign players.

Registrations must be made online by filling out the entry-form on www.federpitchputt.it

The closing date is set on Thursday 12nd October 23:59 pm

The Entry List is published real time on the official FIP&P website www.federpitchputt.it

5. REGISTRATION FEES

€70 green-fees included - €50 for players under 18 years old

6. PRIZES

The first five players scratch

Special Prizes: Lady, Seniors and junior scratch.

7. TIE&PLAY-OFF

In the event of a tie for the first position, a "sudden death" playoff will be played on holes 1 and 17.

In the event of a tie for the other positions, the leaderboard will be determined according to the score of the last 18 – 36 – 9 – 6 – 3 holes. In case of further tie, a draw will be applied.

8. AWARDS

On Sunday, October 15th, there will be an awards ceremony at the end of the tournament.

The presence of winners for the awards ceremony is required.

9. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

A Tournament Director and a Tournament Committee will be appointed, the names of which will be made public at the hosting club, along with tournament conditions, specifications and local rules.

The tournament Committee reserves the right to modify, if necessary, the tournament conditions.
